



Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted that all children will be returning to school in September. Following Government guidance, we would therefore like to reassure parents that lots of measures have been put into place to ensure school is as safe as possible for children, parents and staff.

Class Bubbles

Each class/year group will be a 'bubble' and contact between them both in and around school will be minimised, including staggered start/finish and break times.

Staggered Start and Finish Times

From September, children from each class will be asked to arrive at school at a particular time. It is really important that these times are adhered to so that we can minimise the amount of people in the school yard. Please can we also advise that only one parent drops and collects your child and that you leave the school building as soon as your children have gone in. The times for each class are below. If this presents a problem with siblings, please get in touch with the school.

Upon arriving in school, all children will be required to apply hand sanitiser provided by the school. This will then be repeated at break times, lunch times and home times.

Parents/Carers

For everyone's safety, parents/carers will not be able to enter the school building without prior appointment. If you need to speak with a member of staff, please contact the school office to arrange this. Any questions please do not hesitate to phone the school office.

Equipment

It is recommended that children limit the amount of equipment they bring into school each day. Children can bring a bag in with their packed lunch, water bottle and reading book. However, please can we ask that no pencil cases are brought into school. Children will be provided with their own pencils, pens etc. to use in school.

Uniform

Children should wear their uniform to school each day. However, this should be cleaned more often than usual as the virus can live clothing for several hours. As

we are going to be encouraging more active lessons outside, please can all children have appropriate footwear - black trainers are ideal!

Break times and Lunch times

Children will remain in their class bubble for break times and lunch times. 2 or more bubbles may have their break at the same time but they will be kept separate and have their own designated area. In the event of bad weather, break times will be spent within the classrooms.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

We understand the importance of these clubs, particularly for working parents. However, following the guidelines, at present, we feel this would be too much risk in mixing too many children from different bubbles. We will constantly monitor this to reopen them as soon as possible, as we know working parents depend upon them.

Although our school will look very different in September we are very much looking forward to seeing all children back to school where they belong with smiles on their faces. In the meantime, may I take this opportunity to wish you all a safe summer holidays with your families.
