We have been very fortunate at our school; we have had **no** cases of COVID 19 in school. Therefore, our school continues to be **fully open**.

You will be aware of the recent government announcement that we have moved into Tier 2 with local restrictions in place. Unfortunately, we have been informed there are positive cases within the community. Therefore, we have decided in the interest of the safety of our pupils, parents and staff to ask parents to wear masks on the approach to school and within the school yard while dropping off and picking up your child/children. Please could you also wear your mask from getting out your car or walking on the pavements nearby and through the school gate, where it is difficult to socially distance.

Parents are to wear masks from Monday October 19th. The last thing any of us want is a partial or full school closure, or increase cases within the community, so I hope you agree this is a necessary step to protect everyone at our school.

Please can I remind you if you need to speak to the class teacher to stand 2m distance apart while speaking to them. You are also welcome to use your child's class email to communicate or phone the school with any questions.
