This year marks the 25th anniversary of the World Book Day event. We will be holding some special events and celebrating on **Thursday 3rd March**.

Children will be able to come into school dressed as their favourite book character and we will be doing lots of reading activities throughout the day to celebrate our love of reading!

In the run up to our World Book Day event, we will be setting the children a reading stars challenge, to read in different places/to different people over the half term. Children can tick off a star for each challenge they complete and then receive a certificate in school for completing the whole Reading Stars challenge.

Throughout the day, we are hoping to hold an online live event with an author/illustrator, where pupils can listen to an extract from one of their stories and they will also answer some questions.

Finally, on the day your child will receive a £1 book token. This can be used towards any book that your child may have had their eye on, or can be spent on any of the £1 World Book Day event books. 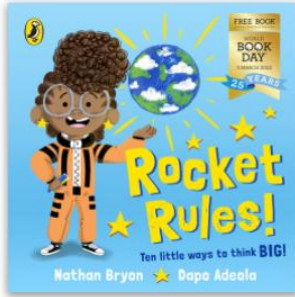
We hope your child will enjoy celebrating their love of reading books with us and will rise to the Reading Stars Challenge!
