Please continue to record your child's reading in their log as rewards will be given to children who read on a regular basis at home. Homework continues to be set on Times Tables Rockstars and Spelling Frame. If you have any issues logging in then please let a member of staff know and we can help.

### PE kits

Our PE days are a Tuesday and Wednesday. They will need to come into school in their PE kits on these days. The school PE kits consists of a school purple PE top, black shorts/jogging bottoms and gym shoes/trainers.

PE shorts and tops can be bought from the [totstoteams.com](http://totstoteams.com) website along with the rest of the school uniform. If the PE days need to change, I will inform you via the class email system as soon as possible.

### Water bottles

Children should bring a **named** water bottle to be kept in school. It may only contain plain water. No fizzy pop, sparkling water or juice please. It will be sent home daily to wash and children are responsible for their own bottle.
