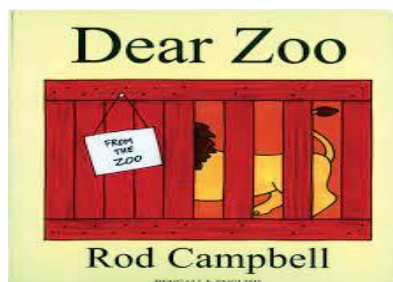
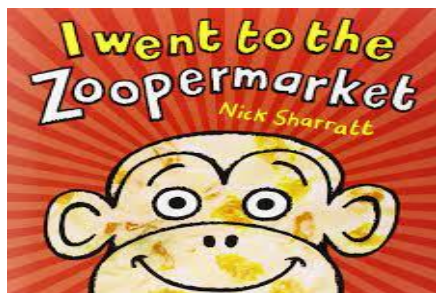
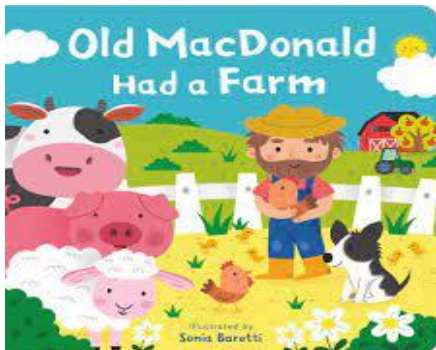
Not ALL children will be going to forest/beach school together. This is due to staffing levels. You will be notified when it is your child's turn.



What's happening this term?

Our topic this term is 'Life Cycles, Farm and The Jungle.' We will primarily focus on the stories of The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Old McDonald, The Zoopermarket and Dear Zoo. The children will be trying different foods just like The Very Hungry Caterpillar. We will be encouraging children to copy words, phrases and re-tell stories. Children will be encouraged to learn the names of the animals and the sounds that they make.

Mathematics- Children will be encouraged to count in sequence. We will be continuing to identify and name colours, sorting and matching objects. The children will be looking at repeated patterns, copying a block structure, learning and understanding concepts (big, small, tall, short) and prepositions (in, on, under, next to.)



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
