Reading and Homework

Some children will continue to be given 2 reading books per week. The Read Write Inc Book Bag Books should be read independently by your child and will be changed on different days each week by their group teacher. Their second book is a book to read together and this will be changed once a week by the class teacher. Please can all books and book bags be brought into school each day as we read in class every day. Please continue to record your child's reading in their log as rewards will be given to children who read on a regular basis at home. Homework continues to be set on Times Tables Rockstars and Spelling Frame. If you have any issues logging on then please let a member of staff know and we can help.

Year 2 SATs

During the month of May, your child will be sitting their Year 2 SATs. These are completed in small groups and the children get very excited to spend time in a different part of the school. There is no pressure put on your child at any point and they are not timed. We will inform you of your child's results as soon as we can. If you have any questions, then please do ask a member of staff or send an email to the class mail box. This is also a reminder that no holidays should be booked during May Term Time.

Water bottles

Children should bring a **named** water bottle to be kept in school. It may only contain plain water. No fizzy pop, sparkling water or juice please. It will be sent home daily to wash and children are responsible for their own bottle.

Trips

We are going to Hardwick Park in Sedgefield for the day on our next school trip on 24th May. We will be exploring plants in the environment. Another letter will follow with more information.



Remember to check your emails regularly as we use the class email system and **Marvellous Me** to update our parents with notices. Please update the office if there are any changes to your contact information.

As the weather gets warmer, sun cream should be applied before school on sunny days and your child can bring in their own named bottle to reapply it at lunch time. They should also bring in a sun hat to wear at break times when the weather is nice enough. Please make sure everything is labelled.
